We are now taking nominations for the 2018 Shooting Australia Coach, Official, Volunteer and Club of the Year awards. This is your chance to publicly thank and acknowledge the contributions made by a Coach, Official, Volunteer or Club. Any individual, club or state can nominate an individual or club they believe is worthy of recognition and meets the following criteria.

► The **“SA Coach of the Year”** must be an active volunteer coach who has made an outstanding contribution to coaching in 2018 and demonstrates the following;

1. Demonstrated commitment to quality coaching
2. The development, progress and outcomes achieved by coached athletes
3. Supporting, developing and contributing to the education of coaches more broadly
4. The use of innovation or new ideas or techniques to improve coaching and athlete performance
5. Overall impact of coaching for the sport of shooting

► The **“SA Official of the Year”** needs to be an active official who has made an outstanding contribution to officiating in 2018 and demonstrates the following;

1. Demonstrated commitment to officiating
2. A proven positive impact on other officials and event delivery
3. Supporting, developing and contributing to the education of officials more broadly
4. Overall impact of officiating on the sport of shooting

► The **“SA Volunteer of the Year”** needs to be an active volunteer who has made an outstanding contribution to the sport of shooting in 2018 and demonstrates the following;

1. Demonstrated commitment to officiating
2. A commitment to positively contribute to their club/s, State or National Association
3. Significant contribution through their actions, work and time to the sport of shooting
4. Work selflessly for the betterment of their club/s, state or National Association
5. Overall impact of volunteering on the sport of shooting

► The **“SA Club of the Year”** needs to be an active club that has made an outstanding contribution to the sport of shooting in 2018 and demonstrates the following;

1. Participated in National Come and Try May in the year of nominating
2. A positive and welcoming experience for members and guests
3. Strive to deliver good governance
4. Development opportunities for coaches, officials, athletes and volunteers
5. Increased registrations (provide club registrations and number if increased members)

All nominations must be endorsed by an Office Bearer of your Club / State Association, accompanied by a recent photo.
