



## 2020 ISSF Jury Nomination Process

The end of nomination process is the **16<sup>th</sup> of September**, nominations submitted after this date will not be accepted.

In order to be eligible to be put forward to ISSF:

- Have a current ISSF Officials License A or B
- Have been actively part of a minimum of two of the 2019 Shooting Australia Performance Series and other domestic level competitions
- Have a high level of knowledge of the safety and rules of your discipline and the sport as a whole
- Have a positive and respectful attitude
- Have a proven ability to adapt to multiple circumstances
- A willingness to learn and experience unfamiliar situations
- Have and continue to behave in a way that is in line with the Shooting Australia Codes of Behaviour

Shooting Australia will review each nomination form and, using the above criteria, will nominate five Australian officials to the ISSF, three from Rifle, Pistol and RTS and two from shotgun.

You will receive a letter from ISSF by the end of the year, only if you are successful.
