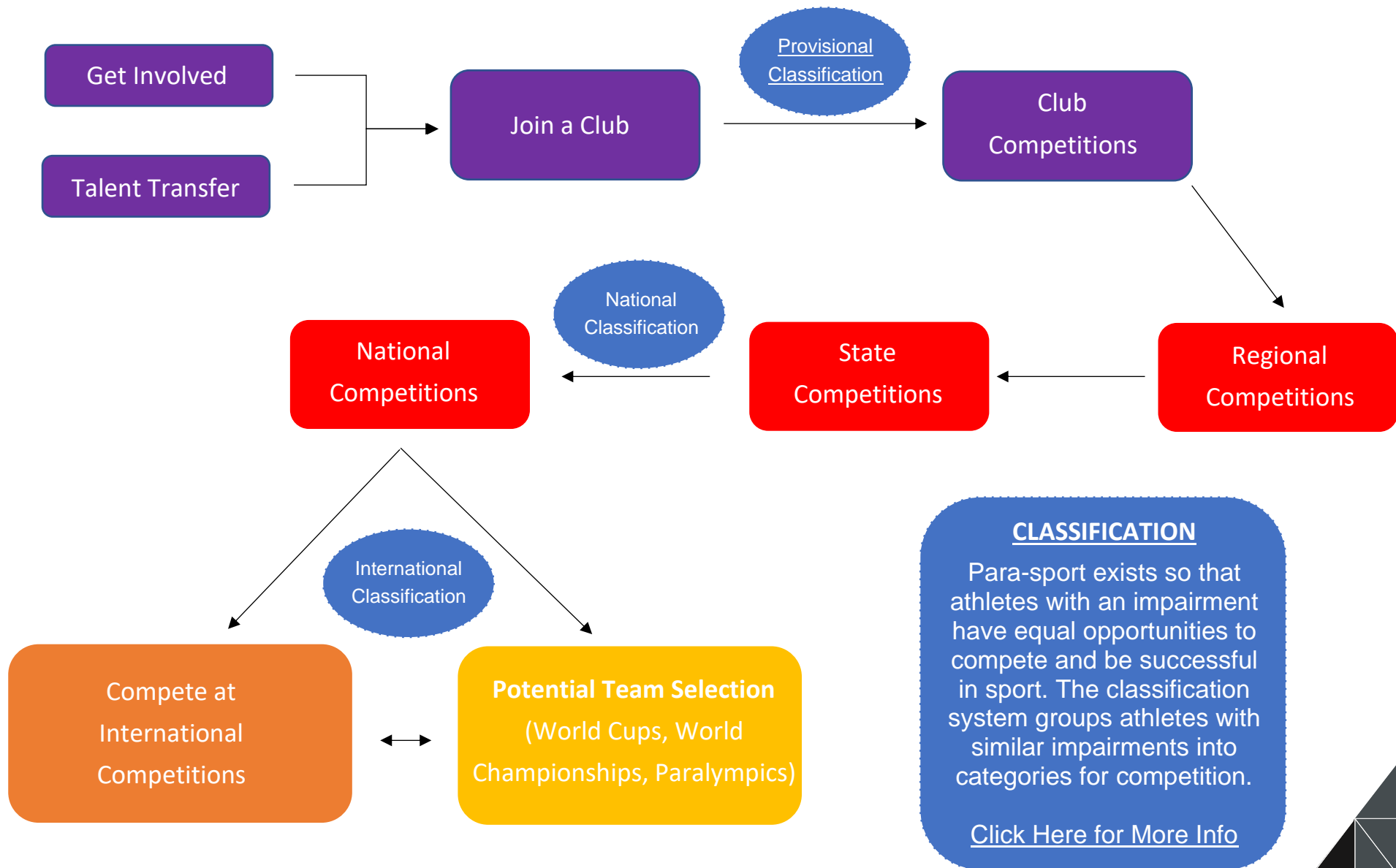


SHOOTING AUSTRALIA PARA-SHOOTING PATHWAY

Get Involved

Talent Transfer

Athletes classified in other sports can contact Shooting Australia or Paralympics Australia about the potential to get involved with shooting

Join a Club

Become a member of your local club and obtain your firearms license. Work with your local coach. Provisional Classification is obtained by submitting the relevant paperwork to Shooting Australia - <https://shootingaustralia.org/classification-page/>

Club Competitions

Compete against members of your club to develop your technical knowledge and skills

Regional Competitions

Compete against members of different clubs in your region to increase competition, knowledge and skills

State Competitions

States & Territories hold their own championships where athletes can become a state champion

National Competitions

There are a range of national level competitions where you can compete against the best shooters in the country. You will be required to have a National Classification to compete

International Competitions

There are a range of International level competitions where you can compete against the best shooters in the world. International classification will take place at this stage, and will be organised through Shooting Australia

Selection for World Cups, World Championships, Paralympics

Shooting Australia has a Selection Policy in place for anyone wanting to compete at the highest level
