EVENT FORMAT – OCEANIA CHAMPIONSHIPS VS OCEANIA OPEN

The OCH is the premier shooting event in the Oceania region, and this year will provide opportunities for athletes to win Paris 2024 Olympic Quota places for their National Federation.

To increase participation opportunities, Shooting Australia will be running a domestic Open event, separate to, but alongside the Oceania Championships for athletes not selected to National Federations A & B Teams. Qualification for both components will be conducted concurrently but there will be separate finals for each of the Championship and Open competitions.

National Federations are responsible for the entry of their athletes and teams into the Championship events. Championship events are not open for athletes to enter individually.

Oceania Championship events will have separate finals for men and women where applicable.

The scheduling of the Championship event finals will be prioritised ahead of Open event finals.

4. COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the 2023 OCH is included in *Annexure C*.

The Final Competition Schedule (including any unofficial and/or pre-event training, athlete reporting, preparation and sighting etc) will be available after final entries close on 13 October 2023.

The latest updates to the competition schedule will be provided at the Technical Meetings.

5. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The competition will be conducted according to the 2023 ISSF Rules and Regulations V2 published on 9.05.2023. Detailed information is available on the ISSF website [ISSF RULES](#). Should the ISSF update the rules and regulations prior to the commencement of competition, this will be communicated.

All finals will be conducted in the Paris 2024 Olympic Finals format as published by the ISSF 20.04.2023 [FINALS FORMAT](#). Should the ISSF update the finals format prior to the commencement of competition, this will be communicated.

ISSF Juries (Jury of Appeal, Competition Juries, RTS Jury and Equipment Control Jury) will supervise the OCH and have been endorsed by the ISSF. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will assist with the conduct of the competition.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however strongly recommended. Athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing

It is recommended that all rifle athletes submit their jacket and/or trousers to Equipment Control for inspection prior to the commencement of competition. All clothing must be ISSF compliant and in accordance with the ISSF Rules and Regulations. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified.

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO₂ cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

Shotgun Equipment

All skeet athletes must have ISSF seals with serial on their marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have ISSF seals on the marker tapes must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, strongly recommended. Athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

Shotgun Cartridge Controls

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a random draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g and

below, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weigh more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified.

During Finals, all six (6) finalists will/must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Finals and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Finalists must report at least 15 minutes before the start of the Final. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once ammunition is placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals (there will be no elimination for 6th place; the first elimination will be for 5th place).

Coloured Wads

Only transparent or translucent wads with no colour may be used.

6. PARTICIPATION IN CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

- a) The Championship Events are only open to Athletes who are officially entered by their Federation within the Oceania region.
- b) Oceania Championship Teams Event for A and B can only be entered by Federations within Oceania.
- c) A total of 14 Paris 2024 Olympic Quota places will be available only to Federations that are full members of the Oceania Shooting Federation and directly affiliated to the ISSF.

- d) Athletes entered for Olympic quota places must be entered in the Federation's A Team. A country may enter a maximum of 6 athletes in each event, comprising 2 teams of 3.
- e) Championship Events will be conducted in accordance with the ISSF rulebook [ISSF RULES](#).

- f) Championship Event Finals will be conducted where applicable and only those entered in the A Team will be eligible and up to 3 athletes per Country. Should there be insufficient entries in a shotgun final (ie less than 6) fillers may be used.
- g) Athletes entered in the B Team will be eligible to make the Open Event final.
- h) There will be no separate WSPS Championship events.
- i) There will be no separate Junior Championship events. However, a medal will be awarded to the best male and female Junior in each event and based on their qualification result. In the event of a tie, a countback will be used to determine the winner.

Qualification and Finals

- a) All Athletes who are entered in both Championship Events and Open Events (including Juniors and WSPS) will shoot qualification together.
- b) Championship Event Finals will be conducted where applicable and only those entered in Team A will be eligible and up to 3 athletes per Country. Should there be insufficient entries in a shotgun final (ie less than 6) fillers may be used.
- c) Athletes entered in Team B will be eligible to make the Open Event final. Refer to the General Information Open Events here [GENERAL INFORMATION OPEN EVENTS](#)
- d) Championship Event Finals will take priority over Open Event Finals and will be scheduled first.

7. ISSF ID NUMBER

Championship Events

All Athletes who are entered in the Championship Events in Team A or Team B must have an official ISSF ID number issued before the commencement of the OCH.

Athletes without an ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form [ISSF ATHLETE ID](#).

Please refer to your National Federation if you are required to submit an ISSF ID application.

8. MINIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

Championship Events

The ISSF has no rules for minimum participation to distribute Quota Places in the applicable Championship Events so long as:

- a) The competition is conducted in accordance to ISSF Rules.
- b) There are a maximum of 3 Athletes in Team A per Federation per Championship Event
- c) The competition complies with the Paris Olympic Qualification System [OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION SYSTEM](#).

9. CHAMPIONSHIP EVENT ENTRY PROCESS

Preliminary Entries

Each Oceania Federation to submit its Preliminary Entries through here [OCEANIA CHAMPIONSHIP ENTRIES](#) not later than **30 August 2023**. Shooting Australia will confirm receipt of the Preliminary Entries by email.

Final Entries

Oceania Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to Shooting Australia by **29 September 2023** via email to events@shootingaustralia.org.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline which is 13 October 2023. An additional fee of \$50 AUD per entry will apply.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from 5pm AEST **13 October 2023** onwards, will not be allowed to participate.

Important Note

Up until the **26 October 2023** (3 days prior to the Official Arrival Day) the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names / athletes within a Championship Event
- b) Change of athlete from Team A to Team B and vice versa
- c) Change of athlete from within a Championship Event to an Open Event

Entry Confirmation Upon Arrival

All Team Leaders of Oceania Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **26 October 2023** onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event can be made only before **12:00pm on the day before the Pre-Event Training** for that event.

Cancellation

Any Oceania Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after **13 October 2023** will forego the entry fees for the reduced athletes and the entries payable will be in accordance with the number of entries on the Final Entry list. If the applicable entry fees are not paid, no member of that Federation may participate.

Competition Entry Fees (as set by the ISSF)

The entry fees are payable in AUD and include all charges for registration, competition costs, doping control and GST.

The Entry Fees DO NOT include the cost of the Pre-Event and Unofficial Training, transportation fees, meals, or ammunition.

11. ACCREDITATION PROCESS

All persons involved in the OCH (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Volunteers, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations will be prepared by the Organising Committee and must be worn at all times when on the range. Accreditations can be removed when Athletes are competing.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organising Committee on Official Arrival Day after confirming that the payment of the entry fees has been made.

BISC – Rifle / Pistol

The shooting range is the range used for the 2018 Commonwealth Games and is equipped with SIUS electronic scoring targets.

The shooting range has 3 Trap and 3 Skeet ranges each equipped with Laporte Traps.

The firing direction of the shooting range is East.

The targets used for the OCH and as supplied by Eurotarget are the Saggiario 2000 for Qualification and the Winner orange fluorescent (flash) for Finals.

13. IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS REQUIREMENTS

VISA

Importation of Firearms into Queensland and Exportation out of Queensland

Each international competitor will be required to apply for and be issued with a Visitors Licence through Queensland Weapons Licensing. Information regarding Visitors Licences can be found [here](#).

Within the Visitors Licence application there is a question about importing firearms and firearm details. Once that section is completed and the Visitors Licence is issued by Queensland Weapons Licensing, they will generate a B709 (import permit) for the firearm/s. Both the Visitors Licence and the B709 will then be emailed to the applicant. Australian Border Force will also be notified.

The exportation of firearms out of Australia is controlled by Australian Border Force. An Export Declaration Notice (EDN) is required and may need to be accompanied by a Restricted Goods Permit (RGP). EDN and RGP forms must be submitted minimum 28 days prior to travel (ie, departing Australia). More information is available [here](#).

14. FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION STORAGE

An armoury will be available at both the BISC and the BGC.

The armoury will be opened from the Official Arrival Day until the Official Departure Day, any teams arriving / departing outside of these dates please must make prior arrangements by email to events@shootingaustralia.org. Please ensure you have a current firearms licence when checking in a firearms licence and/or ammunition.

For arrival please note: Upon your arrival in Australia (Brisbane), all firearms and ammunition have to be transported to the Shooting Range **directly**. The armoury will be open from 8am on the official arrival day.

For departure please note: All firearms and ammunition have to be removed from the armoury for direct transit to the airport, on the day of departure, not before. All firearms and ammunition must be removed from the armoury no later than the official departure day.

15. AMMUNITION

Competitors may bring ammunition with them but should consider the limit which is permitted by the airlines.

While in Australia, all firearms and ammunition must be stored in the armoury at either shooting range.

The storage of firearms and ammunition in the hotel and outside of the shooting range is strictly prohibited. The Armoury will be open to facilitate the arrival of official teams until departure.

Doping Control

Doping Control Tests will be conducted according to the ISSF Anti-Doping Rules and in accordance with the ISSF Test Distribution Plan, under the supervision of the Technical Delegate.

Pre-Event Training (PET)

BISC and the BGC will request to view your firearms licence (and import permit as applicable) upon arrival to each day of practice. Please ensure you have them with you at all times. You will also be required to have your licence and permit (where applicable) with you every day of the competition.

WIFI

WIFI will be available at both the BISC and the BGC. There will be no charge for the use of WIFI. Access details will be displayed around the ranges.

Catering

Food and drink will be available for purchase at both the BISC and the BGC throughout the duration of the OCH.

21. MEDAL CEREMONIES

Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range immediately after the end of each series of Finals. This will be detailed in the final competition schedule (*Annexure C*) when final entries have been received.

During the Championship Event ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform.

Flags and Anthems

All participating teams (Federations) are required to bring with them three (3) national flags (1x2m) and one (1) copy of their national anthem (USB), and deposit them with the Organising Committee during the accreditation process.

22. WEATHER INFORMATION

The average temperature in Brisbane, Australia in November ranges from 19 to 26 degrees Celsius with an average of 23 degrees. The city experiences a rainfall of 100mm over 13 rainfall days. Humidity can be high.

23. MEDIA RELATIONS

All Media representatives must register their attendance prior to arriving at the OCH. Limited on-site press facilities will be available. Upon arrival, all media representatives must sign in and receive their media accreditation. Drones are not permitted in the grounds.
