International visitors will also need to arrange with Australian Border Force Authorities any relevant import and export permits and other required paperwork.

Venue

All events will be conducted at WASRA's Smallbore Rifle Range in Whiteman Park International Shooting Complex. The smallbore range is fully equipped with 30 x 50m and 16 x 10m Meyton Electronic Scoring targets plus 32 x 20m and 32 x 90m paper targets lanes.

Entry Conditions

- Entries close 3rd March, 2023
- Any practice after arrival day is at shooters own cost. Range Fee is \$10 per day + targets where needed.
- Squadding and finals times may vary depending on entry numbers and time constraints.
- Late entries only accepted if bays are available and accompanied by Late Fee of \$10.00 per match.
- Entry into grades and other categories is included in Open Entry Fee when appropriate details are provided with entry.
- Appropriate squadding arrangements to permit sharing of equipment will only be considered if a suitable note is made on the Entry Form and shall be dependent on entry numbers.
- For contestants in events running concurrently consideration to provide adequate time between squads is not guaranteed but will be made where ever possible.

Competition Conditions

- The Nationals will be conducted in accordance with ISSF, WSPS (IPC) & approved TRA Australian Supplementary Rules.
- WASRA & TRA Board reserve their right to amend the program at any time where necessary.
- Entry form available from a Nationals Portal on either website; TRA (<u>www.tra.org.au</u>), WASRA (<u>www.wasra.asn.au</u>).
- ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE A FINANCIAL MEMBER OF TRA OR SIMILAR INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION.
- At time of registration a current Membership Registration Cards, WA Temporary License and Shooter's Licences must be presented.
- All Competitor's squadding details will be provided at time of registration.
- Shooting mats will NOT be provided but personal mats must conform to current ISSF specifications.
- Finals for WSPS events may be held when there are more than 3 entrants in an event.
- During qualification and finals music will be playing.

Entries and squadding advice:

Entries need to be lodged by 3rd March 2023. Late entries will only be accepted if space permits and details of a valid WA Police Temporary Firearms permit number are provided. Entry fee is for Open Events but may include grades and other categories when stated in Event Details below.

Please note, start times for each squad, may vary depending on the number of squads required.

Firearms Licences, transport, storage and range safety:

Secure storage for firearms will be available on site. Area for storage of other equipment cannot be assured.

West Australia law does **NOT** recognise a firearms licence issued by any other Australian jurisdiction. ALL competitors MUST have a Temporary Firearms Permit issued by the WA Police Licensing Service. This permit will be issued FREE to all entries received by 3rd March and all required details of firearms and travel dates have been provided to Organisers. Any later entry may need to pay the \$113 Temporary Permit fee.

To get a **MANDATORY** WA Police Temporary Firearm Permit all competitors will need to provide firearms details being carried into WA. *Collection of all firearm details will ONLY be done AFTER the organisers receive an entry form. Organisers will request each competitor to lodge personal details either on-line via a secure WASRA web site or a request, using a separate application form, will be posted with return envelope.*

Every effort will be taken to ensure the security of this information and it will only be provided as required by WA Police Licensing personnel for the purpose of issuing a Temporary Firearms Permit.

10m Air Rifle Men/Women Match:	ISSF 10m Air Rifle match format. All decimal scoring. Men's Final to determine Men's Match. Women's Final to determine Women's Match.
National Air Rifle Championships:	 ISSF 10m Air Rifle match format. All decimal scoring. Open to both Men and Women. Open Final to determine a National Championship. In conjunction – Open, Junior, Veteran, Grades, Open and Junior State Teams, – Champion of State 10m Air Rifle Champions.
Supported Air Rifle Match:	TRA Auflage Supported 10m Air Rifle inclusive match. Open to all competitors. In conjunction – Open, Veteran Champion
ISSF Prone Match:	ISSF 50m Prone Match format. All decimal scoring. Open to both Men and Women. Men's Final to determine Men's Match. Women's Final to determine Women's Match.
Jim Smith 50m Championship:	Open and Graded 120 shot x 50m prone match over 2 days (60 shots each day) ISSF 50m prone match both days. All decimal scoring. Open Final to determine a National Champion. In conjunction– Total Day 1 & 2 – Open, Men, Women, Junior, Veterans, Grades. – Day 1– Champion of State 50m Prone Champions plus Open & Junior State Teams.
Bill Eddy Dual Range Match:	Open and Graded: 60 x 20m TRA Prone– Day 1; 60 x 90m TRA Prone – Day 2 TRA 20m and 90m prone targets. All whole ring scoring. Combined Dual Range score – Open, Men, Women, Junior, Veterans and Grades.
Benchrest 50m Match:	Open and Graded to both Men and Women: Day 1 – 60 x 50m; Day 2 – 60 x 50m Open to all TRA classified benchrest rifles - Aust Supplementary Rules - A.24, A.25 All decimal scoring and electronic targets will have an Offset sighting target. A.21.6 Open, Men, Women, Junior, Veteran, Grades plus Open & Junior State Teams.
Benchrest Dual Range Match:	Open to both Men & Women: Day 1 – 60 x 20m; Day 2 – 60 x 90m Open to all TRA classified benchrest rifles - Aust Supplementary Rules - A.24 TRA Benchrest 30 x 20m (A.21.3) and 5 x 90m targets (A.21.9). All whole ring scoring. Combined Dual Range score – Open, Men, Women, Junior, Veteran and Grades.
50m F Class Demo Match	Inclusive TRA (WASRA Draft Rules) 50m match format. All whole ring scoring. Electronic targets will have an Offset sighting target. A.21.6 Three rifle categories – Sporting, Light and Open Target – Open, Junior.
WSPS (IPC) matches:	Format of all matches as per current WSPS (IPC) Rules.

Medal Presentations:

Presentations will be conducted as soon as possible after a final result is posted in each event.

Trophies, Awards and Medals:

All awards, medals, certificates & trophies will be presented as specified & endorsed by our TRA Board.

Grades:

When a Match includes Grades entry is automatic ONLY when a TRA grade or scores are provided at or before registration. Graded match entry will not be assumed if Competitors doesn't provide relevant details. A competitor's Dual Range Match Grade will be the same as their 50m Grade.

Range Directions:

Access into our Whiteman Park Range next year may be challenging due to major rail and roadworks in the vicinity. Changes will be ongoing until well after our National Championships. A Google Map search for "WASRA" should provide reliable directions out to the Tonkin Highway and Hepburn Avenue interchange. There are many good routes to drive from anywhere in Perth to get to this interchange and then its last 5km along Beechboro Rd then into Hennessey Rd and along Jules Steiner Memorial Drive at 40km/hr. The back page enlargement shows more detailed directions of that last 5km into our Smallbore Range.

DO NOT USE any access into our range off Drumpellier Drive (east) side of Whiteman Park.

If any unexpected road changes happen then WASRA will make every endeavour closer to the Nationals to communicate any new or changed details.
