We ask if you are unwell at any time, please stay home and take care of yourself.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. All resident Australian competitors must be current financial members of Pistol Australia.
- 2. Competitors may be asked to prove they are a current member of their State/Territory association.
- 3. Entries close Monday 22nd April 2024. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Committee. Entry Fees must accompany the Entry Form and or payment notification supplied.
- 4. Entries without full payment will not be accepted.
- 5. Phone entries will not be accepted.
- 6. Provisional State/Territory team lists to be received no later than 27th April to assist squadding.
- 7. It is preferred that Training Day Range Fees are paid with entry this is for your non-competition days. (a range fee is applicable every day a person fires a shot on the venue)
- 8. Pistol licences/permits must be submitted for checking at Equipment Control.
- 9. Competitors, officials, and visitors to the range will be required to sign the Non-Competitor Register each day.
- 10. Competitors, officials, and visitors must wear enclosed footwear, eye and ear protection as required.
- 11. Competitors are not permitted to wear tank tops, garments with loose fitting necks or camouflage clothing, PA Dress Code applies.
- 12. ISSF and Pistol Australia Rules will be followed as closely as is practicable.
- 13. Firearms and gun boxes must not be left unattended anywhere on the venue.
- 14. Handguns and competitors' equipment (gun cases, bags etc) are not permitted in the club house at any time.
- 15. Signage will indicate Safe Areas. These areas are to be used for any handling of uncased firearms.
- 16. No ammunition is permitted in any Safe or Warm up area.
- 17. Full metal jacketed (FMJ) projectiles are prohibited on all ranges.
- 18. 9mm calibre ammunition is prohibited on all ranges.
- 19. Mobile phones used on the range must be in Flight Mode, before entering any ranges.
- 20. Smoking/Vaping is not permitted on any range at any time. Please use designated smoking areas.
- 21. Alcohol is not permitted on any range at any time.
- 22. Alcohol may be consumed at the conclusion of the competitor's program for the day.
- 23. **Media release**: by entering this competition, you acknowledge that all results will be published on the PA, PSQ, and BISC websites and social media platforms. You also acknowledge that video footage and your photograph may be taken during this competition and may be published on all PA websites, social media platforms and/or TV including future Range Reports.
