1. WHAT IS THE 2024 SHOOTING AUSTRALIA ENDORSED EVENT SERIES?

A Shooting Australia domestic competition series held within a specified period of time (eg a calendar year) shall form the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series**. These events will typically be held in conjunction with a Club, State Association or National Member Organisations and will include ISSF (and the WSPS equivalent) events across the Pistol, Rifle and Shotgun disciplines.

All the events that form part of the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series** will provide a platform to encourage greater competitive participation throughout the ISSF (and the WSPS equivalent) disciplines.

At the conclusion of the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series**, the Shooting Australia High Performance staff in collaboration with the Member Organisations, will have the opportunity to nominate and vote on an athlete to be awarded a High Performance Program Award across Pistol, Rifle, Shotgun and Para, based on their performances throughout the domestic competition season. The four winners will be announced at the 2024 Shooting Australia Awards of Excellence.

2. WHO CAN COMPETE IN THE 2024 SHOOTING AUSTRALIA ENDORSED EVENT SERIES?

Any Able-Bodied Athlete or Para Athlete who competes in an ISSF (or WSPS equivalent) discipline can compete in the *2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series*.

The 2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series offers athletes an all-inclusive and unique opportunity to participate in a national domestic series of endorsed events. Throughout the 2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series, athletes will have the opportunity to complete in high quality domestic competitions. This can mean differing things for different competitors including a training platform for National Team members, an opportunity to show progression in results to support consideration for selection into National Squads and/or National Teams or a pathway into ISSF (or WSPS equivalent) competition from a non ISSF target shooting sport discipline.

Only current financial members of a Shooting Australia Member Organisation, or athletes who are members of the applicable organisation of a National Federation outside of Australia, are able to compete in any of the Shooting Australia endorsed events.



3. WHAT WILL THE 2024 ENDORSED EVENT SERIES BE USED FOR?

The 2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series aims to achieve five primary objectives:

a) Domestic Nomination Events for AUS Olympic Team (AOT) Selection

Some events within the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series** will form part of the domestic events in accordance with the Paris 2024 Olympic nomination criteria. These events have been clearly identified and classified as Tier 1 events.

b) National Team Selection

- 2024 Junior World Championships
- 2024 World Cups and Grand Prix's (ISSF and WSPS)

Some of the events within the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series** will be identified as events that will be used for National Team selection for Junior World Championships and collectively, these events will be referred to as **Selection Series**' specific to the National Team being selected.

Performance in the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series** events may also form a component of National Team Selection for World Cups and Grand Prix's in 2024.

c) 2025 National Squad Selection

Results achieved within the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series** may be considered to support the selection of an athlete to the 2025 National Squad.

d) Average Performance Score

The Tier 1 and Tier 2 events that comprise the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series** will provide domestic opportunities for Athletes to record a performance score that will go towards their Average Performance Score (APS).

Shooting Australia uses the APS to review athlete progress and may determine eligibility for selection to National Teams and/or squads.

e) Officials and Volunteers

The 2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series will provide an opportunity for:

- ISSF Licensed Officials to remain active in Officiating at domestic ISSF events;
- Volunteers and Officials to become active in ISSF Officiating;
- Officials to receiving mentoring and experience as part of Shooting Australia's ISSF Officiating Scholarship Program.

4. DETERMINING AN ENDORSED EVENT

In the assessment of which events will be Endorsed Events, and therefore, part of the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series**, Shooting Australia asked for the submission of Expressions of Interest from prospective event hosts interested in hosting an endorsed event in 2024.

Upon the receipt of the Expression of Interests, Shooting Australia worked with the Member Organisations and its High Performance Team to determine the 2024 endorsed event program. Consideration to the following was given:

- The number of events required in 2024to provide National Team nomination/selection opportunities
- An adequate number of competition opportunities for the purposes of developing athletes in National Squads
- The events that already exist in the annual calendar that Shooting Australia can endorse, including National Championship events delivered by the Member Organisations and State Championship events delivered by State bodies
- Ranges that can facilitate competitions to ISSF standards and/or the endorsement of an event can assist the range/facility development to reach these standards
- How Shooting Australia can ensure a fair allocation of Endorsed Events nationally

National Events

National Championship events that are delivered by the Member Organisations will receive automatic endorsement, provided they meet minimum event delivery standards. These National events include:

- Target Rifle Australia (TRA) ISSF Nationals
- Pistol Australia (PA) ISSF Nationals
- Australian Clay Target Association (ACTA) ISSF Nationals



Paper Targets v Electronic Targets

A pistol or rifle event can receive endorsement from Shooting Australia if it is shot using either paper or electronic targets. However, for a pistol or rifle event to receive endorsement and also be considered part of a selection/nomination series e.g. 2024 Paris Olympic Australian Team domestic nomination events and 2024 Junior World Championships Selection Series, electronic targets **must** be used.

5. 2024 ENDORSED EVENTS

There will be a number of events across each of the disciplines between January and November 2024. These Events will be categorised into two tiers:

Tier 1: Endorsed Events – Selection

Pinnacle endorsed events delivered by event hosts that will be used to provide a selection opportunity for:

- Paris 2024 Olympic Team
- 2024 Junior World Championships

Tier 2: Endorsed Events – Performance

Endorsed events to provide additional opportunities for Athletes to record a performance score to go towards their APS as well as competition opportunities for the purposes of developing athletes in National Squads. These events will **not** form part of any National Team selection series as identified for Tier 1 events.

6. RULES

All athletes will be expected to adhere to their National Association rules, in conjunction with ISSF and WSPS rules as applicable.

7. JUNIORS

For the purposes of National Team selection e.g. 2024 Junior World Championships, a Junior will be defined in accordance with ISSF rule 3.7.4.12 (updated April, 2023).

"Athletes will remain as Juniors until the 31st December of the year in which they become 21 years of age. Any athlete born between the 1st January and the 31st December, will cease to be a Junior on the 31st December of that year."

For the purposes of prize giving to Juniors at any event in the 2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series, the definition of a Junior will be in accordance with the relevant National Association rules.

8. ENDORSED EVENT RESULTS

Although there will be no allocation of endorsed event series points during the *2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series*, all event results will be displayed on the Shooting Australia website <u>here</u>.

WSPS Events

Event Hosts may choose to schedule separate WSPS events as part of the 2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series. These will be advertised and may be subject to minimum entries. In the event of no separate WSPS events, WSPS athletes may enter a competition that best aligns with the ISSF equivalent. See table on the following page.



There may also be opportunities during the 2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series for WSPS athlete classification, and this will be communicated accordingly.

Greater participation from WSPS athletes (classified or otherwise) will be encouraged at all endorsed events during 2024.

10. EVENT ENTRIES

Event entry deadlines will be advertised for each event in the *2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series*. Event entry caps for maximum entries in any event may also be advertised.

The acceptance of late entries will be at the discretion of Event Hosts. Event Hosts are under no obligation to accept late entries. Event entry capacity may be taken into account and Shooting Australia may be consulted to determine the suitability of the acceptance of a late entry. A late entry fee may be payable by an athlete, at the amount and discretion of the Event Host.

12. EVENT DELIVERY INTERRUPTION

Shooting Australia, in partnership with the event hosts, will endeavour to deliver a complete domestic series of endorsed events in 2024. However, issues may arise outside of the control of the event delivery and consequently may require an altered event, rescheduled date or event cancellation.

13. HEAT AND ADVERSE WEATHER

Shooting Australia and the Event Hosts have a duty of care to monitor environmental conditions and to take action to minimise the risk of heat stress to athletes, officials, volunteers and spectators attending any events in the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series**.

In addition to any heat risk, Shooting Australia and the Event Hosts also have a duty of care to monitor/examine weather forecasts prior to the commencement of competition to determine any possible adverse weather conditions that may impact the event and result in a delay, postponement, rescheduling or abandonment.

14. RESPECTFUL BEHAVIOURS

It is expected that all participants in the **2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series** (athletes, officials, volunteers, hosts and spectators) show respect and act responsibly, professionally and with integrity at all times. Participants should not engage in any activity that may bring the sport of shooting into disrepute or damage its reputation or standing in the community.



15. SPORTS INTEGRITY AND NATIONAL INTEGRITY FRAMEWORK

Shooting Australia has adopted the National Integrity Framework (NIF) through Sport Integrity Australia (SIA). The NIF is a suite of policies that sets out the broad expectations for the conduct of all participants in sports. It is designed to mitigate integrity threats to sports and provide a safe, fair and healthy environment for participants at all levels of sport.

It is important that all athletes, volunteers and event hosts are familiar with the policies within the NIF as this will be important during the *2024 Shooting Australia Endorsed Event Series*.

The policies in the NIF include:

- Improper use of drugs and medicine policy
- Safeguarding children and young people policy
- Member protection policy
- Competition manipulation and sports gambling policy and
- Complaints, disputes and discipline policy.
