

# PARIS 2024 OLYMPIC GAMES

## Qualification Ranking for Olympic Games (QROG)

Last updated: 1 August 2023



### Eligibility Requirements for Paris 2024

For Paris 2024, the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) has made some changes to the qualification process that was in place for Tokyo 2020. A key change relates to the eligibility requirements for athletes to compete in Paris 2024. These include:

### Clause C3 – Additional Eligibility Criteria

#### **C.3. Additional eligibility criteria:**

Athletes will also need to achieve the following in order to be eligible to participate in one (1) or more of the individual events at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games:

1. Be listed in the Qualification Ranking for the Olympic Games (QROG) ([https://www.issf-sports.org/getfile.aspx?mod=docf&pane=1&inst=474&file=ISSF-Ranking-system\\_2022.pdf](https://www.issf-sports.org/getfile.aspx?mod=docf&pane=1&inst=474&file=ISSF-Ranking-system_2022.pdf)) with at least one (1) ranking point achieved for each of the individual events they are to be entered for at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.
2. Have participated at least in two (2) ISSF Championships during the Qualifying period for each of the individual events in which they are to be entered for at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.
