- Bipod or non-adjustable front rest.
- No back bag/rest.
- Unlimited power scope.
- Non trigger hand or forearm may be used to support rear of rifle.
- Shot from bench or prone.
- TRA Benchrest target.

10m AIR RIFLE - State Champion will be determined by results of Saturday's Air Rifle Match.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

- 1. Competitors must be affiliated with their state association & be members of a TRA affiliated smallbore club. Shooters' licence and QTS Membership card MUST be presented on registration. International visitors welcome.
- 2. ISSF, WSPS & TRA Supplementary rules apply.
- 3. All grading in accordance with the latest state grading list. Any shooter not listed must supply their last 5 club scores otherwise they will be graded as 'A' Grade.
- 4. The Range Register must be signed before any competitor commences shooting
- 5. Brett Stephenson Memorial Trophy awarded to highest ranked Junior U18 prone from Championship Match.
- 6. Random draw for all events with consideration for WSPS athletes, those competing from a bench and those competing in multiple events.
- 7. Medals and awards dependent on entry numbers per grade or category.
 - 1 3 competitors Gold only.
 - 1 6 competitors Gold & Silver.
 - 7+ competitors Gold, Silver, Bronze.
 - 1 competitor Certificate only.
